



Discussion Questions Conversations With Jesus Week Seven

1. Pastor Jeremiah stubbornly does not believe in Musk Oxen. Was there ever a silly lie or an Urban Legend that you believed in? Please share with your group what it was like to discover the truth.
2. This contentious interaction in John chapter 8 occurs between Jesus and want-to-be followers. Was there, or is there, a place in your life that you had to face to move from an interested observer of faith into discipleship?
3. Are there worldly labels that you are tempted to hold to for identity?
4. Jesus wants his disciples to "hold to" him (John 8v31), and he promises to "hold to them" (John 15v4). This is the path of freedom. How can you hold to Jesus and believe his promise this week?
5. The crowd gets nasty and angry towards Jesus, especially as he gets closer to their core lie. As a group, gently identify some lies you are tempted to believe. Pray for each other. Allow space to hold to Jesus instead of those lies.
