



Discussion Questions Conversations With Jesus Week Six

1. Share about a time in life you felt spiritually & emotionally satisfied. Why is satisfaction such a good feeling, and why is it often temporal and illusive?
2. **Read John 6:1-21**
In this story, Jesus is demonstrating that he is the second Moses by doing two things that Moses did:
 - 1) Feeds the people in the wilderness
 - 2) Leads the disciples through the seaWhat does it mean that Jesus is the second Moses?
3. **Read John 6:25-36**
Jesus says in this passage that he has come to offer "eternal life." What does he mean by this?
4. Jesus tells the crowd that follows him that all they want is miracles and bread, but that *He* is the bread of life. How have you tried to use Jesus to get what you want instead of allowing him to give you a life you can't imagine?

5. In the middle of this exchange, the crowd asks a critical question – "What must we do to do the works God requires?" In other words, how do we receive this bread of eternal life you are offering? Jesus replies, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent." The word 'believe' is the word 'faith' or 'trust'. How does faith or trust lead you into a life of peace, hope, joy, satisfaction, and fulfillment? How have you seen or experienced this kind of faith & life?

6. Spend time in prayer asking God to reveal a way to actively trust Him this week.
