

Discussion Questions Conversations With Jesus Week Two

Read John 2:1-11

- 1. John goes out of his way to say that this first "sign" happened in Cana of Galilee. How is that significant for how the Kingdom of God does and doesn't move forward?
- 2. What do you think it does and doesn't mean that Jesus' first miracle/sign is keeping a party going by providing 4,607 glasses of wine?
- 3. Mary's statement, "Do whatever he tells you" is a model for how to experience the heavenly life. When has Jesus asked you to yield to His way or His timing?
- 4. One of the messages of this passage is that life in Jesus is the best. This is the best wine, and these jars are filled to the brim! Is your vision for life with Jesus a "filled to the brim" life? Where do you struggle with this? How have you experienced the abundant joy of life with Jesus?
- 5. One thing about this story is that most people miss the miracle. How are you doing at recognizing the work & power of God in this world? Are you tuned in or oblivious? What might raise your antenna to God's powerful presence around you?

- 6. John concludes by saying that through this sign, Jesus "revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him." The word "believed" is the word for faith. What do you think that word means, and what does it look like to live with more of it?
- 7. What else stands out to you in this story & what do you think it means for your life?
- 8. In the end, this story is a picture of the Gospel. When we were unable to cleanse ourselves, Jesus' blood shed on the cross wholly and entirely cleansed us in a way we could never accomplish on our own. Spend some time in prayer thanking God for the life of joy he offers and for all the ways he has cleansed you from sin.
