

Discussion Questions Good & Evil Week 05

Share:

Genesis 1-3 helps us understand the tension we often feel between 'life is good' and 'this world is broken'. In that spirit, share a memory from your childhood that was especially good OR one that was especially hard.

Search: Read Genesis 3:1-7 What stands out to you in these verses?

What is the lie of the serpent in verse 4, and how do you see people buying that lie in their lives today?

Where are you tempted to act like God's ways aren't quite right, and you know better?

Read **Genesis 3:8-13** What stands out to you in these verses?

Choose 1 of the following 3 questions God asks Adam & Eve to answer in your group:

1. "Where are you?"

Where are you in life right now? What are you trusting in for safety & protection? Where are you tempted to hide in times of stress, pain, confusion, fear, or failure?

2. "Who told you?"

Who is defining truth and reality for you? What voices are you listening to (people, podcasts, media, your own feelings...) that may want to give you an altered understanding of the truth?

3. "What have you done?"

This last question is an invitation for humble, honest confession. Is there anything you need to confess to God this week? To a trusted brother or sister in the Lord?

Read **Genesis 3:14-24** What stands out to you in these verses?

What do you think the message is & is not?

Prayer:

This fallen, broken world can be challenging. Share a place where you struggle to trust God *and* where you have seen God's redeeming work. Pray for each other.
