

# Discussion Questions Good & Evil Week 07

## Share:

When you think of the story of Noah, what comes to mind? Do you have fond memories of singing songs in Sunday school, or does this story bring up doubts & questions for you?

## Search:

What sticks out to you when you read **Genesis 6:1-8**? What do you notice? What observations do you make? What do you think the message of this passage is?

# Read **Genesis 6:9 – 7:5**.

What sticks out to you about this part of the story?

Each of these two sections begins with a statement about Noah's righteousness & concludes with a statement about Noah's obedience.

What is the connection between righteousness & obedience?

Why is Noah's obedience in this moment so commendable?

If the main message here is that God is looking for people to trust and obey him in a fallen world, share where/how God specifically asks you to trust and obey him in your life these days?

## Read Genesis 7:6-24.

This is a story about the catastrophic impact of sin & evil, but it's also about God's justice and judgment of sin.

What do you notice about this section? Is this passage hard for you? What do you think the message is here?

## Read **Genesis 8:1-14**.

The very first verse of chapter 8 reminds us that God remembers those who trust and follow him.

Share about a time when sin, evil, and brokenness had you in a place where you were struggling to survive (physically, emotionally, financially, relationally, or spiritually) & God remembered you and came to your aid.

## Pray:

Break into smaller groups of 3 or 4 and use the following questions to share and pray for one another.

- 1. Where do you need strength for faith, trust & obedience these days?
- 2. Is there a place in your life where you need to know that God remembers you and sees your struggle?
