Share:

Think back about this series and what you've learned that has stuck out to you. Has or will anything about your life shift after spending eight weeks in the first chapters of Genesis?

Search:

Read Genesis 7:17-24.

The sea in the ancient world was a symbol of judgment & destruction (think about Noah & the flood, Pharoah's army & Jonah). How does this shape your understanding of Jesus walking on and calming the raging sea in the New Testament? What is the message Jesus is bringing to us?

At the beginning of Genesis 8, we read, "But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and he sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded."

Share a time when you faced something difficult and felt God remember you.

In Genesis Chapter 9, God establishes a new covenant with Noah (humanity).

- How does Noah mirror Adam, and what is the significance of that?
- What do you think the message of the rainbow is, and how does it speak to us today?

In this chapter, there is also a grievous sin. Read Genesis 9:20-24.

- Why is it so easy to return to sin even after an amazing experience with God?
- How have you seen or experienced this in yourself or others?

In Genesis 11, things continue to spiral downward again. Read Genesis 11:1-9.

- What do you think the sin of Babel was?
- How do you see us struggling with that sin today?

Read Acts 2:1-13.

- What is the significance of Acts 2 being the reversal of Babel?
- What is this saying about the church and who we are called to be?

Prayer:

Spend some time praying for our world, the church in our world, and any place you feel God wants or needs to move into your life.
