

Discussion Questions Moses: Learning to Trust, Finding Deliverance Week Six

1. Exodus 14:1-4

God's people are about to have a horrifying encounter that we are told right away was planned and orchestrated by God. Why would God do this? What do you think he hopes to accomplish, and have you ever had an experience where God used something horrible to accomplish something in your life?

2. Exodus 14:5-9

Here the author carefully highlights the full power of Pharoah's army. Why do you think he does this, and have you ever faced something that you felt completely and utterly overwhelmed by?

3. Exodus 14:10-12

After all that God has done to deliver them, it only takes one difficult moment for them to turn back to slavery. Share when you experienced the temptation to return to something God delivered you from.

4. Exodus 14:13-14

Who is a person in your life who (in a time of struggle, confusion, fear, and temptation) has reminded you to stop, listen, remember & trust what the Lord can do in your life?

5. Exodus 14:15-18

This is the moment of faith, of trust. The command in verse 15 is "move on" or "go forward." Where in your life has, or is God calling you to move on and go forward? Why do you think God wants this for you, and what prevents you from doing it?

6. Exodus 14:19-22

When we are willing to turn away from old securities and move forward with God in faith, we often get an amazing glimpse of God's power. Share about a time when you witnessed God's power as the result of stepping out in faith.

7. Exodus 14:23-31

The summary statement says that the result is that "the people feared the Lord and put their trust in him."

How fully does this statement describe you?

Where in your life is it hardest to trust God these days? Why?

8. In the next chapter, the people worship God. What is the significance of this?

9. What is your big takeaway this week, and how will this passage/message change you?
