



Discussion Questions
Moses: Learning to Trust, Finding Deliverance
Week Three

Read Exodus 3:1-4

What kind of impact do you think Moses' time in Midian (the Wilderness) had on him?
How has the suffering, difficulty, or struggle in your life changed your heart? Is there bitterness, anger & mistrust *or* humility, compassion & grace?

Read Exodus 3:5

Where are the holy places in your life where you meet with and hear from God?

Read Exodus 3:7-10

What do we learn about God in this section? How is this (or isn't this) your experience with God?
What is the significance of God saying He will do this and send Moses? How and where might you apply this to your life?

Read Exodus 3:11-15

What do you think God is trying to teach Moses here?
What is God saying to us about who he is in this story?

Read Exodus 4:1-8

What's the message and assurance God is giving Moses through these three signs? Which one sticks out to you and why?

Read **Exodus 4:9-15**

Why do you think God is so seemingly frustrated with Moses here?

Despite his frustration, God gives Moses the gift of Aaron. How are partners in ministry/difficulties/struggles a gift from the Lord, and who has been an "Aaron" in your life?

What else from this week's message sticks out to you, and how will you change because of learning about the calling of Moses?
