

Discussion Questions Vision Sunday: A Day to Look Ahead Together

Hebrews 10:25 is one place in Scripture where we are told to make the gathering of the church a priority. Do you think our time together on Sundays is important? Why or why not?

Along with our Sunday gatherings, we believe that becoming like Jesus & making him known grows in us through:

1. Intentional & Intimate Connection with God

Describe what you think intimacy with God looks like. What does it mean to be intentional about seeking this? On a scale of 1-10, how intimate do you feel you are with God on a daily basis? What keeps you from being more intimate?

2. Deep Spiritual Friendships

Describe what you think a deep spiritual friendship looks like.

Do you think these kinds of relationships are essential for BLJ&MHK? Why or why not? On a scale of 1 (casual connection) to 10 (deep spiritual friendship in Christ), who is a person (besides your spouse) who rates among the highest in your life? What has prevented you from having relationships that are higher up the scale?

3. Purposeful & Passionate Ministry

How does having a ministry differ from serving or volunteering (which are both good things!)? Why do you think the words "Purposeful & Passionate" were chosen to describe ministry? Do you feel like you have a ministry in your life right now that is purposeful and passionate? Do you have a ministry that involves serving with your church family at Cedar Mill?

On Sunday, Pastor Dave asked us to do three things in response to this message:

- 1. Commit to a Congregation
- 2. Get in a Group
- 3. Find a Ministry

Talk about what your response to this challenge is and why.
